### **Repair of Signpost**

If anyone has wondered about the black and white signpost where Roston Common meets the B5033...you may have noticed it has been damaged, with one of the 'fingers' having been snapped off. While the cause of the damage is unknown, fortunately all the pieces are now safe. The top has been dismantled so that a repair can be progressed. As the broken part is cast iron, it requires a specialist repair (which makes it costly!).

This signpost dates from 1927. Many would love to see it retained rather than replaced with a modern alternative. We have applied for, and received, a grant from the Derbyshire Dales District Council to contribute towards the repair as part of a 'Project Fund'. The repair work has now been commissioned, so in a few months the signpost will be returned to its former glory.
