EMERGENCY - 999 – DON'T PANIC! Keep calm and remember INFORMATION. We have arranged an **OPEN** meeting to everyone on **Tuesday 4th November at 7.30pm in the Village Hall.**

Michelle will talk and demonstrate CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and you will be able to see close up the DEFIBRILLATOR, which is located on the wall outside the village hall.

We encourage everyone (men, women, teenagers, and children) to come and learn, see, and familiarise yourselves with equipment and techniques should you ever need to use them.
