LOCATION OF VILLAGE DEFIBRILLATOR

We are fortunate to have a defibrillator in Norbury and Roston, which is maintained by the Village Hall committee. It is located on the front outside wall of the **Village Hall**. To access the defibrillator and receive instructions and support, **call 999** for an ambulance and they will provide an access code to open the cabinet. A member of the team will stay on the line, supporting you whilst you are waiting for the ambulance to arrive. When the paramedics arrive, they will notify the national emergency response service and take over.
