

Minutes of Norbury and Roston Annual Meeting held on Monday 18th May 2026,7pm in the Mary Clowes Hall

3. **Chairman's Report** – Cllr Steve Davis read out his report (copy to follow)
4. **Matters Arising / Open Discussion**
 - a) **1 member of the public** raised a dispute regarding a cheque that had been returned to them with no explanation & felt that a letter from the Parish Council should have been delivered to them with an explanation.
Response from the Parish Council: The issue got resolved within a few days, back when we were first notified & an online payment transfer was made to said member of the public, we too received no explanation from Lloyds Banking & reassured the member of the public that there was and is still has, sufficient funds in the account. Concerns about the switch of bank accounts may have caused a problem.
 - b) **1 member of the public** requested that all planning applications are displayed on the village notice boards to ensure all parishioners can view the application details.
Response from the Parish Council: stated that the full planning applications can be viewed on the planning portal on <https://www.derbyshiredales.gov.uk/planning>. It was agreed that the Clerk would display the reference number & summary of the applications on the village notice boards, in the village flyer & on the community website.
 - c) **1 member of the public** raised their concern with the grass triangle on Lid Lane / Church Lane, stating that because of the motor vehicles using this as a pull in for passing they find it difficult to mow the grass when the ground is churned up.
Response from the Parish Council: it was agreed that the Clerk would investigate the options into getting the triangle kerbed via the Derbyshire Dales District Council & in the meantime suggested that strimming the grass may be a better option rather than mowing.
